Of India, invites applications from suitable Indian Nationals for appointment on the following Purely temporary posts (**on contractual basis**) under the project entitled “Implementation Research for Point of Care Diagnosis of Visceral Leishmaniasis in India”, sponsored by Grand Challenge Canada.

Duration of contract: The appointment will be made on consolidated pay initially for a period of 12 months, likely to be extended for next year till end of the study period.

Qualifications and experience for the above posts (Serial-wise)

The essential/ desirable qualifications and experience for the above posts, as per serial number, are given as under:

S.No.	Essential/ Desirable Qualifications & Experience
1	(1) Essential Qualification: (i) MBBS, M.D./ M.S. from Institutions recognized by MCI. (ii) Ten Years experience in field of case management/ Control Program Management/ Clinical drug trials for any vector borne disease. (2) Desirable: Above experience in the field of Kala-azar (Visceral leishmaniasis) will be preferred. (3) Age: The candidate should not be more than 65 years of age.
2	(1) Essential Qualification: (i) First Class M.Sc./ M.A. in Statistics from a recognized University. (ii) Diploma or any higher degree in Computer application. (2) Desirable: (i) Three years experience in field of data compilation, management and Statistical Analysis related to field based epidemiological study/ Disease surveillance / Disease Control Program. (ii) Experience of data analysis using statistical software like SPSS. (3) Age: 18-35 years.
3	(1) Essential Qualification: (i) Graduate in life Sciences from a recognized board. (ii) Two years diploma in DMLT from a recognized Institution. (2) Desirable: (i) Diploma in Computer applications. (ii) Three years working experience in field-based activities or in medical/ research laboratory. (3) Age: 18-28 years.

Age Relaxation: For the posts of Statistician (S. No. 2) and Field Technician (S. No. 3), age may be relaxed up to 5 years for Government servants, technical staffs working in long term project in ICMR Institute/ Centre and SC/ST/OBC Candidates. However, the prescribed age may be relaxed in exceptional cases for experienced and qualified candidates.

Job Requirement for the above posts (Serial-wise)

The Job requirement for the above posts, as per serial number, are given as under:

S.No.	Job requirement for the above posts
1.	The Project Manager will be responsible for coordination of all the project related activity in their respective district assigned. He/ she will ensure daily operations consistent with the milestones. He will also ensure proper data management at PHC and submission to the Principal Investigator’s and Co-Investigator’s office in right format and well in-time. He/ she will liaison with the Government Health Machinery to resolve the study related issues, if any.
2.	The Statistician will initially design the database according to the survey tools. He/ she will perform data entry after ensuring data completeness and data integrity; generate data query log, if any, to resolve the issues. He/ she will also perform interim and final data analysis and reporting.
3.	The Field technicians will be responsible for conducting the field work to collect blood samples, perform rapid diagnostic test, identify kala-azar patients based on the passive reporting at the Govt. set up, interviewing the patients and head of the household. He/ she is also supposed to perform data entry and electronic data submission.
